Message from the President

The Board of Directors of the Fraser MacPherson Music Scholarship Trust Fund have decided to broaden our original mandate and to provide funding for workshops in B.C. schools and universities. Hence, we are encouraging music educators to apply to have a jazz artist/clinician assigned to your program to provide a 90-minute workshop, working with your instrumental jazz students in your classroom. This will only work if you agree to a 50/50 partnership, where your school provides \$100 towards the professional fee and the Fraser MacPherson Music Fund matches it with an additional \$100. Applications are now being accepted until Oct. 30, 2009. We anticipate that decisions will be announced early in 2010.

This Jazz Workshop Grant program is made possible by a grant from the *BC Gaming Commission*.



Jazz Workshop Grant Overview

The *Fraser MacPherson Jazz Workshop Grant*, funds a jazz artist or clinician to attend a school in British Columbia to perform and work with students in an instrumental jazz program. The award is \$100.00 that must be matched by the school to create an operating budget of \$200 for the workshop. Members of the Fraser MacPherson Jazz Scholarship executive will coordinate the workshop and payment of artists. Our members are committed to making this experience as meaningful as possible. We will work with schools and teachers to find artists that will best help the program and address the needs of the students and their groups.
