The Festival kicks off with a free Downtown Jazz concert series outside the Vancouver Art Gallery and ʔxwʔənəq Xwtl'e7énk Square and includes marquee shows at Queen Elizabeth Theatre and Vancouver Playhouse, plus club shows at various downtown venues, and culminates on Canada Day weekend at Granville Island venues including Performance Works, Ocean Artworks and The Revue Stage.
